Dr. W. deleted some breaths in #10. I'll give you what applies to basses, but they also apply to other sections, although in different places. (Remember to use pencil.)

In general, breaths still separate repetition in text.

Changes:

"offer him (no breath) glory and might," or

"offer to the Lord (no breath) glory and might,"

examples for basses:

Pg. 69/3rd. system/meas. 2 (abbreviated 69/S3/M2)

70/S1/M1; 70/S2/M2; 70/S3/M4

71/S1/M4; 72/S1/M2; 72/S2/M2; 73/S1/M4

74/S3/M1 "...Him--all ye..."

"Lord" always ends with a "d" sound

and is pronounced like "Law..."d"
