LINEUP will be similar to that of Church of the Epiphany = standing on 4-level risers with a row of chairs in front.

In general, we stand through the entire performance. If you are in the chair row, you may stand the entire time; stay seated if unable to stand; or sit only during movement 5.

BE ON TIME.

The "Call" is 2 p.m.

We line up at 1:50; go on the risers at 1:55; rehearse at 2:00.

Space on risers and the chair row are the same as at Epiphany because Soprano 2s will be on the additional standing risers. Ergo: BE ON TIME.

MUSIC is carried in your right hand. Lower your music in your right hand after movement 4 has completely ended and Mark has lowered his hands. Raise and open your music at the beginning of movement 6 when Mark raises his hands.

PURSES, BAGS, COATS

Leave purses, bags and valuables in your locked car. Bring in your car keys and emergency supplies in your black fanny pack, small black shoulder purse, money belt or someone's pocket. If it is raining or very cold we could leave coats in the band rehearsal room. It is not a secure place, but there will be no space on stage.

Don't leave anything on the ramp into that room since our chorus will go down that ramp to enter stage right.
