ADVICE FOR NEW MEMBERS

Welcome!

NOVA Community Chorus is an eighty-voice ensemble combining singers from the NVCC Music Program and the surrounding community. The group performs regularly at the Schlesinger Center with the Alexandria Campus Band, the Alexandria Symphony, and the Washington Metropolitan Philharmonic. The repertoire is varied, singing everything from Bach to Bernstein, madrigals to contemporary. For over 20 years, it is a great way to experience great music.

Rehearsal Tips

- Sheet music may be acquired from the campus bookstore.
- For class / rehearsal, bring sheet music, pencil(s) with eraser, and water.
- Be on time. There will be a brief warm-up at the beginning of class.
- Upon arrival to the class, please sign in on the appropriate section sheet
- If you are new, please provide your telephone number and e-mail address. These are used to distribute important information to chorus members. Most announcements are sent via e-mail.
- Please do not talk during rehearsal. If you have difficulty with something, quietly ask your section leader or an experienced singer to help you. The section leader will ask the director for help if they cannot resolve your problem.
- Watch the director and mark your music.
- Please refrain from wearing scented products, including perfumes, some hair sprays, etc. Also be mindful of oral hygiene.

TIPS, CONTINUED

Attendance

- Additional optional rehearsals may be scheduled.
- Attendance at dress rehearsals is required.
- If a singer misses more than two rehearsals for a particular performance, they will be asked to audition to demonstrate preparedness.

Parking

It is recommended that singers acquire semester parking permits. Not only will this cover parking costs for regular classes, but also for any extra rehearsals, dress rehearsals and NVCC event / concert parking.

Section Leaders

Each section has an assigned leader to assist members with questions and concerns. They are also responsible for recording attendance and being accountable for members missing from rehearsal.
